A graduate of the University of Ottawa's Business Administration certificate program and an accredited instructor in Non-Violent Physical Crisis Intervention, Mr. Roberge is the recipient of the Canadian Peacekeeping Service Medal, the United Nations Mission in Bosnia Hercegovina (numeral 2) Medal, the Queen Elizabeth II's Golden Jubilee Medal as well as the RCMP Long Service and Good Conduct (Silver Clasp and Star) Medal.
